

New York State Continuing Education requirements:

Effective January 1, 2004, to renew your NYS registration as a Chiropractor, you are required to complete 36 hours of continuing education credits in each three-year registration period (valid dates are found on your NYS license registration).

- Of the 36 total hours, a minimum of one-third (12 hours) **must** be in Category 1 topics (Ethics, RecordKeeping/Documentation, Risk Management, NY Law, and/or Patient Communication).
- The remaining two-thirds (24 hours) may be in Category 2-general topics.
- You may take up to one third (12 hours) of either Category 1 or Category 2 courses via a distance learning format (e.g. online text based course or recorded webinars).
- A live webinar is a real-time, interactive, internet based program & is therefore considered equivalent to a live classroom course in NYS. A recorded webinar is available online and considered distance learning.

Courses must be comparable to subject topics taught in professional education programs in chiropractic, offered by higher education institutions that are accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education. All courses must be applied to and approved by NYS no less than 90 days prior to the course date.

50 minutes = 1 CE hour

Up to 10 hours' worth of CE credits can be offered/received on one day.
